To begin this project, you should do the following:

1. Create a twitter account at https://twitter.com

If you already have a personal twitter account, you can use it if you like, but it may be easier for the purpose of this class to create a separate twitter account.

2. Follow my twitter handle @profbreaux

You will notice I have selected various engineering and design thinking schools, societies, and people.

**4.** Choose at least 5 from the list I follow to follow yourself throughout the remainder of the semester. Please be aware some of the users tweet more than others.

**6.** Send me (via email or through Canvas) your twitter handle that you will be using for this project and which 5 (or more) from the list of my followers you have decided to follow By next **Friday, January 31st at 11:59 PM**. This part of the project is worth 10 points.

7. Submit a paragraph summarizing what you learn each week from those you are following every Friday starting on Friday, February 7th (except for the Friday during spring break) by 11:59 P.M. I will create separate assignments in Canvas for each of your weekly reports. Each weekly report is worth 5 points (for a total of 60 points throughout the semester).

If you find additional people or groups you want to follow related to engineering or design thinking, please feel free to do so. If you find someone you think I should add to my list, please let me know by including it in your weekly summary or sending me an email.
