**SECTION 1 - YOUR CHILDHOOD**

Instructions:



- **Past Tense**
- Use clauses with "WHEN", "WHILE" and "AGO"
- What did you "HAVE TO" do as a child?
- What "COULD" you do well?
- What "COULDN'T" you do?
- Use adjectives and adverbs to describe yourself as a child.
- Who are you "LIKE" and "DIFFERENT FROM" in your family?

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**SECTION 2- WHAT YOU ARE DOING NOW**

Instructions:



- **Present Tense**
- Use “TOO” and “VERY”, to describe some things in your life now you like and don't like.
- Use “SOME” and “ANY” to describe what you have and don't have now.
- Using “IF” clauses, describe issues that can happen and how you react to them.
- What “CAN” you do well and what are you “NOT ABLE TO” do or “DON'T KNOW HOW TO” do?
- Compare yourself to *all the other students* in the classroom using superlatives we learned, like “BEST”, and “ONE OF THE”.

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### **SECTION 3 - YOUR FUTURE**

Instructions:



- **Future Tense**
- What "SHOULD" you do?
- What "MUST" you do?
- Use "IN" to write about when your future goals will be.
- Use "LET'S" to tell your family about your plans.
- Use "SOME", "EVERY" and "NO" with *-body*, *-thing* and *-one* to describe how you will plan your future with others.
- Describe yourself in the future using adjectives and adverbs.

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**SECTION 4 - ADVICE**

Instructions:

Write ONE SENTENCE using the *imperative* to give advice to other ESL students at the college.

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**SECTION 5 - QUESTIONS:** Create a question that would result in each response. Watch for the verb used, the tense and subject usage. Write as if this is a conversation between 2 people. Use WH- question words as needed.
