- “An open canvas can be utilized with instructions on how to register online, add/and drop classes, fill out your FAFSA, and search programs and degrees at EMCC and in the district. I would like to make one available in Spanish for our students in ESL”
- “I will be looking into creating a badge for completion of service learning that is required in my CPD150 class. I also enjoyed learning how to embed images into Canvas such as headers and footer to make my Canvas pages more inviting. I would like to see some follow up on having Financial Aid create a Canvas module to distribute all their information more effectively to CPD150 students.”
- “Student Services would be able to utilize Canvas for student disciplinary issues. Sanctions could be loaded to a student’s Canvas for completion. A Student Code of Conduct course would be extremely beneficial as well.”
