Hiring, Training, Goals?

Does having ET reinforce student misconceptions about course difficulty?

Do these tutors hold review sessions as well?

Yes. They hold regular assistance hours and review sessions outside of class in addition to being present during class.

DRS Training - do the tutors take that? Because they will be exposed to information if they're dealing with learning disabilities.

Yes, the tutors are trained by DRS, additionally instructors can provide tutors with instructional strategies to best serve those student needs.

I am interested in knowing how well this is working in online classes

In math, we found face-to-face far more effective than online or live online modalities.

The most consistent data we have on that is from BIO 156 which has been taught with F2F and online sections every semester. Send me (Jeanne) your email I can share more.

In math at EMCC, we have "supervisors" (residential faculty who are compensated) to observe and evaluate adjunct faculty to provide instructional strategies to support

active learning strategies. Residential faculty collaborate with colleagues and we're talking about small PLCs (Professional Learning Communities) on active learning.

Have you experienced problems getting instructors to "buy in" and welcome ETs into their classroom? If so, what strategies have helped you resolve these problems?

The faculty that have participated so far have volunteered for the program and have loved it! :D)

Is this for in person classes only? what about hybrid and online classes

We have ET in online courses for bio and for F2F courses.

Role of Embedded Tutor?

How are the embedded tutors selected? Are they paid? And, how is this structured...do they meet with the professors to prep for the lesson?

We encourage faculty to recommend students for tutors. They do get paid under title V and go through training. They attend class/lab weekly, meet w/ faculty, more!

The enrollment cap was lower due to COVID course caps to ensure social distancing. It has returned to normal leaves.

The role of embedded tutors in in-person classes for activities seems similar to using TAs in certain Universities. The tutors develop a relationship with the students.

We like to emphasize that the Tutors are NOT TA's. They do not grade, teach class, or create assignments. They are "near peers" who partner with the instructor to support students.
