

The goal of the EMCC Strategic Plan and College WIG on Student Completion is to increase college retention and persistence by reducing the within semester withdrawal rate from 16% to 14% by 2026. To contribute to this College WIG, each Residential Mathematics Faculty member will document evidence of **at least one** of the following lead measures:

- Administer and record (SLO) Course/Program/Institutional Learning Outcome data in Canvas/Tableau with the goal to move from 478 students assessed (AY 24 ILO Critical Thinking: Math) to 525 students assessed (9.8% growth rate from AY 24) by Spring 2025.
- Increase college retention rates in at least one MAT course by 2% from Fall 22/Spring 23 by Spring 2025.
